DRIVER RESPONSIBILITY

- Vehicles must be returned to the place of origin, full of fuel, at the scheduled time, and in a clean state (interior).
- Drivers must be registered with the district and meet all requirements to drive district vehicles.
- Drivers must possess a valid California driver's license. Commercial vehicle (10-passenger van) drivers must have at least a Class BP license.
- The vehicle will have a seat belt for each passenger and the driver is responsible for seeing that each occupant uses his/her seat belt.
- Commercial vehicle (10-passenger van) drivers are required to do a pre-trip inspection and a post-trip inspection, as per the California Vehicle Code.
- Commercial vehicle (10-passenger van) drivers are required to submit a vehicle inspection report at the end of the trip, day, or tour of duty as per the California Vehicle Code.
