

# MEDICAL COVERAGE under Medi-Cal

**Medi-Cal provides** medical, dental



and vision care for eligible children, low-income adults, and elderly persons. The

Medi-Cal program also includes services such as Long Term Care and Assisted Living Board & Care, to ensure the health care needs of low-income and elderly persons are met. The HRA determines eligibility for Medi-Cal.

**Healthy Families** provides medical care for children who do not qualify for Medi-Cal and have no other medical insurance.

## County Medical Services

### Program (CMSP)

provides medical care for indigent adults.



## What Services does Medi-Cal cover?

**Medi-Cal is health insurance.**

**Once you have been approved for Medi-Cal, you are eligible for services covered by Medi-Cal. Shasta County Department of Social Welfare can help connect you to a range of services such as:**

**Doctor's Visits**

**Dental**

**Prescriptions**

**Hospitalization**

**Psychologist visits (counselor)**

**Psychiatric visits (doctor)**

**Nursing homes & in-home support**

**Substance abuse treatment**

**X-Rays**

**And more**

## Who qualifies for Medi-Cal coverage?

- Families where a parent is absent, unemployed, or disabled.
- Children under the age of 21
- Pregnant Women
- Undocumented or temporary residents may qualify for full or limited benefits.
- People who receive Supplemental Security Income/State Supplementary Program (SSI/SSP)
- Or Temporary assistance for needy Families (TANF)
- People 65 years or older, blind, or disabled
- People who are in a long term care facility
- Families with higher income can also qualify, You may have to pay a share of your medical costs.
