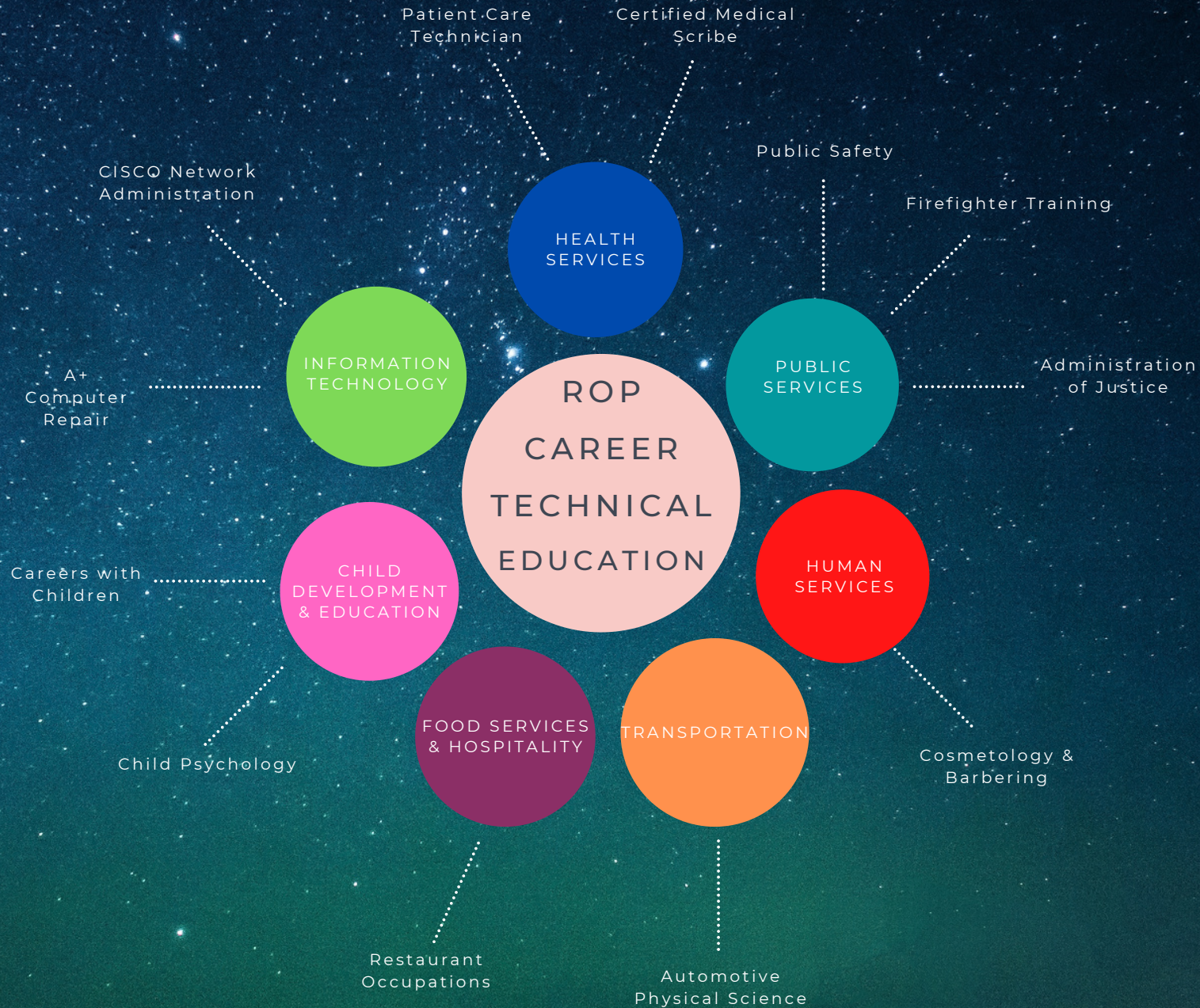


# Regional Occupational Program (ROP) Career Technical Education (CTE)

## Medical Scribe:

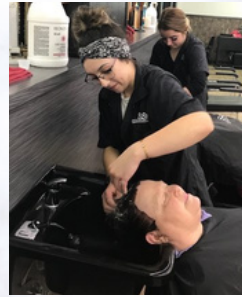
- Offers specific training and preparation to become a certified Medical Scribe

## Restaurant:

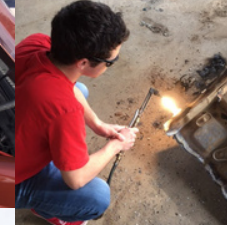
- Full functioning kitchen and restaurant, equipped with industrial grade appliances
