

There are three areas of focus that seniors should pay attention to when it comes to Financial Aid/Scholarships. They are the federal financial aid, the state financial aid and the local scholarships.

Federal Financial Aid

FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) students will complete this application after January 1st of their senior year. Parents will need to use their year-end payroll stubs to estimate their income when filling out their portion of this application.

State Financial Aid

CSAC (California Student Aid Commission) funding is applied for automatically when a student completes the FAFSA and includes a California school as one of the colleges he or she is planning on attending. In addition, the student needs to verify his or her social security number with our Registrar, who automatically sends the senior classes Cal Grant grade point averages (GPA) to CSAC.

Local Scholarships

Keep checking the Scholarship Bulletin for scholarships available for Anderson Union High School students. Your counselor will help you apply for any scholarships you qualify for.
